Eligibility Requirements

- 3. Applicant must meet all of the requisites that are required to show an animal at the Katy ISD Livestock Show and Rodeo. (Please see the eligibility checklist.)
- 4. Applicant must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5.
- 5. Applicant's parents or guardian must be a member of the Katy High School FFA Booster Club.
- 6. Applicant must submit all of the required documents:
 - a. Applicant Information Sheet.
 - b. Official high school transcript.
 - c. Copy of ACT /SAT test score.
 - d. Essay
 - e. Educational Background form, detailing all extracurricular activities and community service projects.

Evaluation Process

The FFA Booster Club Scholarship Selection Committee considers many factors when evaluating applicants for the FFA Booster Club Scholarship. We strongly encourage diversity among our applicants; and expect our recipients to exhibit proven leadership skills and the academic discipline necessary to ensure success in their collegiate endeavors, so that they can become valued leaders of tomorrow, both inside and outside of agricultural communities.

The FFA Booster Club Scholarship Selection Committee will evaluate the candidates on the following criteria:

- Application postmarked on or before March 31st
- All required documents included with submittal
- Applicant must have met all eligibility requirements
- Essay:
 - o No more than 750 words
 - o Times New Roman, 12 pt. font, double spaced, 1-inch margins
 - Essay must communicate:
 - The applicant's college plans,
 - The applicant's future goals, and
 - How the FFA program has influenced them, or the role that the FFA program played in their life as a member of the Katy FFA.
- Applicant's activities within and outside of the FFA program

After reviewing all applications, The FFA Booster Club Scholarship Selection Committee will select one outstanding high school senior to receive the FFA Booster Club Scholarship.

Scholarship consists of \$1,000 per calendar year for (up to) four consecutive years. (See Recipient Requirements for details.)

Scholarship recipient will be announced at the Katy FFA Awards Banquet.

Recipient Requirements

Recipient of the Katy High School FFA Booster Club Scholarship must adhere to the following requirements:

- 1. Submit an official class schedule of work in progress each collegiate semester.
- 2. Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average on a four-point system on all college courses.
- 3. Provide grade reports (official transcript) at the end of each year (by end of summer) to the Katy FFA Booster Board President (before the next check will be issued for the new semester).
- 4. Complete 24 semester hours per year.
- 5. Remain free of disciplinary problems, probation status, and must exemplify good moral behavior. (Recipient is subject to having scholarship revoked upon Scholarship Committee decision.)
- 6. Provide an invoice from the college or university. (All scholarship checks will be written directly to the college or university.)
- 7. The scholarship will be rewarded once per calendar year for (up to) four consecutive years beginning with the year immediately following graduation.
